On Saturday February 24, the First Annual Ladies Go-Kart Race will be held in Kathmandu, Nepal. It is an event where women of all ages can come together and compete for the championship – no prior experience is needed. It is a chance for women to enjoy a day of racing in good company and experience the thrill and exhilaration from go-karting. The karts only have an accelerator, a brake and no gear box; therefore it is easy to drive even for new drivers.

The race will be started at 10 am and every participant will be in two pre-qualifying heats in order to determine who will proceed to the quarter-finals, then semi-finals and finals.

The price for participating in the race is Nrs 3,000 and interested participants can sign up at Elephant House (tel: 2191500)

All the proceedings from the event will be donated to the Nepal Bal Ghar, an orphanage in Kathmandu.

**About the go-karts:**

All karts are assembled in Kathmandu, Nepal. The karts use an engine with 5.5 British horsepower with 166cc honda engine, and all karts can run at the speed of 55 kilometers per hour. The karts are one-seater and stand only two inches above the ground. The karts have one accelerator, one brake and a steering wheel; there is no gear system so the karts are easy to drive even for unexperienced drivers.
